 Organisation, organisational changes 	 Director General, Margrét Hauksdóttir, began her second five years term from 1 May 2018.
	 A new frame law on Register Iceland was adopted in Alþingi in June 2018 and will enter into force on 1 September 2018.
	 Government Election took place in Iceland in autumn 2017. Mr. Sigurður Ingi Jóhannesson took office as new Minister of Transport and Local Government on November 30th, 2017 for the Progressive Party. He holds a Master's degree in Veterinary.
	• After changes in the law of the State Budget, Registers Iceland was placed in a category called Statistical reports, State primary databases, and Information policies along with NLSI.
• Vision, strategy	• The vision is to save customers time and effort by providing first class service anywhere and anytime.
	• Registers Iceland carries out its role by being the center of electronic solutions, maintaining basic databases, running electronic services, and evaluating real estate. We issue certificates and certificates based on a solid foundation.
