- Nordic Cadaster Workgroup Meeting was held in Gavle 10 and 11 of April with 11 parthshipants. Agenda/key themes.

    - Key finding: Growing need from society and from our organizations to set standards and improve processes.
  - Initiatives that have been made to improve the quality of the cadastral map during the last year.
    - Key finding: Improving the quality of the cadastral map is an ongoing project and all countries are taking steps to improve.
