Main restrictions

- Larger gatherings is limited to 100 people
- Social distance rule is two-meter between individuals who do not live together. The rule applies to all businesses, workplaces and public establishments. Masks shall be used where the two-meter rule can not be respected, such as flights, ferries, hair salons etc.
- Colleges and universities are allowed to maintain one-meter social distance
- Opening hours of nightclubs and bars is to 23:00
- Many have downloaded the contract tracing app for COVID-19



Border screening

Passengers arriving in Iceland on and after 19 August 2020 may choose either to submit to two screening tests for COVID-19, separated by five days' quarantine until the results of the second test are known, or else not to undergo border screening but instead to spend 14 days in quarantine after arrival.

National Land Survey of Iceland



- About half of the staff worked from home while earlier episode, Use of Teams increased
- More strict rules inhouse 2 meters distance, sanity, rules in the kitchen, limited access for guests.
- After experience of working from home, all employees may now work "outside of office" twice a week on Wednesdays and Fridays (used to be once a week).
- Saving of time and money with less traveling inland and abroad
