

## Reporting from working group

The Nordic land registration working group is currently not active. Sweden has held the presidency for 2 years but wants another participating country to take over the chairmanship. There have been challenges in transferring the chairmanship of the working group and since corona, the activities in the working group have been extremely limited. Therefore, no results from the last year can be presented and no work program is planned for the coming year.

In continuation of this, a task was formulated at the Lille Chef Møde in March for an ad hoc group in relation to the framework for possible future co-operation between the Nordic countries in the area of land registration.
